FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

- SB 7 will allow county detention centers to join the Department of Corrections (DOC) telecommunications contract. The department has approached the vendor about amending the current contract to allow this change and they are agreeable.
- The amendments to 53-30-153, MCA should not affect DOC. The bill would require DOC to include an option for a county detention center to "opt-in to a telecommunications contract at the same per-minute rate offered to" the DOC. Although there may be fiscal impact to counties, SB 7 should have no fiscal impact to DOC.
