
Description of fiscal impact: HB 867 would allow an agency liquor store to be open seven days a week from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. at the agency liquor store agent's discretion. The bill would also allow the Department of Revenue to impose a fee to recoup the costs of recovering inventory from an agency liquor store who fails to timely make payments on liquor purchased from the liquor warehouse. Besides any fees imposed, there would be no fiscal impact to the Department of Revenue.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions:

1. HB 867 allows agency liquor stores to be open seven days a week from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. at the agency liquor store agent's discretion, subject to local ordinances.
2. The bill also allows the Department of Revenue to recoup the costs of recovering inventory from an agency liquor store who fails to make timely payments on liquor purchased from the state liquor warehouse.
3. The fee the Department of Revenue would impose will vary by several factors including, but not limited to, the location of the agency liquor store and the amount of inventory that must be recovered.

4. The fee imposed against the agency liquor store agent in default would be sufficient to cover the time involved by the Department of Revenue to recover the inventory, as well as other direct costs such as transportation, travel, and supplies.
5. There would be no additional cost to the Department of Revenue to implement this bill.
