### FISCAL ANALYSIS

**Assumptions:**

- Sections 1 and 2 extend the sunset of Chapter 339, Laws of 2011 (HB 622) which provides a statutory appropriation from the Livestock Loss Reduction and Mitigation Restricted Account. A statutory appropriation from the Predatory Animal State Special Revenue Account is also extended.
- Under current law, the appropriations would be zeroed out and under HB 59 the appropriations are extended. Therefore, the net fiscal impact is zero.
