

1 (13) have a corporate seal and flag;

2 (14) acquire by eminent domain, as provided in Title 70, chapter 30, any interest in property for a
3 public use authorized by law;

4 (15) initiate a civil action to restrain or enjoin violation of an ordinance;

5 (16) enter private property, obtaining warrants when necessary, for the purpose of enforcing
6 ordinances that affect the general welfare and public safety;

7 (17) conduct a census;

8 (18) conduct inventories of public property and preparatory studies;

9 (19) condemn and demolish hazardous structures;

10 (20) purchase insurance and establish self-insurance plans;

11 (21) impound animals and other private property creating a nuisance or obstructing a street or
12 highway;

13 (22) establish quarantines;

14 (23) classify all violations of city ordinances as civil infractions, with civil penalties, as provided in 7-
15 1-4150; and

16 (24) exercise powers not inconsistent with law necessary for effective administration of authorized
17 services and functions; and

18 (25) prohibit or otherwise regulate the unauthorized occupancy of or camping on or in public
19 property or facilities owned by or under the control of the municipality."
