6 BENEFITS; REVISING THE RATIO OF TOTAL BASE PERIOD RELATIVE TO CERTAIN FULL WEEKS OF
7 BENEFITS; AMENDING SECTION 39-51-2204, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND AN
8 APPLICABILITY DATE."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 **Section 1.** Section 39-51-2204, MCA, is amended to read:

13 **"39-51-2204. Maximum benefit amount.** Any otherwise eligible individual is entitled during the
14 individual's benefit year to a total amount of benefits equal to the individual's weekly benefit amount, as
15 calculated according to 39-51-2201, times the number of full weeks of benefit entitlement appearing in the
16 following table in the line which includes the individual's ratio of total base period earnings to the highest quarter
17 of earnings in the base period:

Ratio of Total Base Period Earnings to High Quarter		Full Weeks of Benefits
At Least	But Less Than	
1.00	1.25	8
1.25	1.50	10
1.50	1.75	12
1.75	2.00	14
2.00	2.25	16
2.25	2.50	18
2.50	2.75	20
