4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REVISING CERTIFICATION OF PETITION SIGNATURES TO
5 ADD A FILING TIMELINE; AMENDING SECTION 13-27-302, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE
6 EFFECTIVE DATE."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 13-27-302, MCA, is amended to read:

11 "13-27-302. Certification of signatures. (1) An affidavit, in substantially the following form, must be
12 attached to each sheet or section submitted to the county official:

13 I, (name of person who is the signature gatherer), swear that I gathered the signatures on the petition
14 to which this affidavit is attached on the stated dates, that I believe the signatures on the petition are genuine,
15 are the signatures of the persons whose names they purport to be, and are the signatures of Montana electors
16 who are registered at the address or have the telephone number following the person's signature, and that the
17 signers knew the contents of the petition before signing the

18 petition. _____ (Date on which the first signature was
19 gathered) _____ (Signature of petition signature
20 gatherer) _____ (Address of petition signature gatherer)

22 Seal _____ (Person authorized to take
23 oaths) _____ (Title or notarial information)

24 (2) (a) The signature gatherer or an agent of the group gathering signatures shall submit the
25 affidavit provided for in subsection (1) and the signature sheet or the section to which the affidavit is attached to
26 the county election administrator within 4 weeks of the first collected signature covered by the affidavit.

27 (b) If the affidavit and the signature sheet or the section to which the affidavit is attached are not
28 submitted within 4 weeks of the earliest signature covered by the affidavit, the county election administrator

1 shall reject the filing and may not process it further."
