4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REVISING PROCUREMENT REPORTING REQUIREMENTS;
5 AND REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO PROVIDE CERTAIN REPORTS TO THE
6 LEGISLATIVE FINANCE COMMITTEE ON PROCUREMENT SOLICITATIONS, CONTRACTS, AND
7 CONTRACT MODIFICATIONS."

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9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

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11 NEW SECTION. **Section 1. Report to interim committee.** (1) By March 1, June 1, September 1,
12 and December 1 of each year, the department shall provide a written report to the legislative finance committee
13 in accordance with 5-11-210 containing the information listed in subsection (2) related to procurement
14 solicitations and contracts.

15 (2) The report must include:

16 (a) for a procurement solicitation for a contract that the department anticipates will cost at least
17 \$250,000 over the life of the contract:

18 (i) the name of each purchasing agency issuing the solicitation;

19 (ii) what the purchasing agency intends to procure through the solicitation;

20 (iii) the portion of the purchasing agency's appropriation that it intends to use to pay the vendor;

21 (iv) the closing date of the solicitation; and

22 (v) any other information the department finds relevant to the proposal;

23 (b) for a contract executed with or without a solicitation that is expected to cost \$250,000 or more
24 over the life of the contract:

25 (i) the names of the purchasing agency; and

26 (ii) the contractor and the date of execution; and

27 (c) for a contract modification that causes the total value of a contract to exceed \$250,000 over the
28 life of the contract:

1 (i) the names of the purchasing agency; and

2 (ii) the contractor and the date of execution.

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4 NEW SECTION. **Section 2. Codification instruction.** [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
5 integral part of Title 18, chapter 4, part 1, and the provisions of Title 18, chapter 4, part 1, apply to [section 1].

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
