2 (5) investigate the existence of any disparities that may be faced by SMALL, tribal, and rural  
3 government entities when seeking to identify and secure federal grant funding opportunities pursuant to  
4 subsection (1) compared to the state's larger and more urban entities; and

5 (6) recommend strategies and resources that may enhance federal grant acquisition at the state,  
6 tribal, and local levels, including addressing any disparities between all levels of state government.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the interim committee work with stakeholders, including executive  
8 agencies, tribal governments, local government representatives, and federal government representatives to  
9 offer input and proposals.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if the study is assigned to staff, any findings or conclusions be  
11 presented to and reviewed by an appropriate committee designated by the Legislative Council.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all aspects of the study, including presentation and review  
13 requirements, be concluded prior to September 15, 2026.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the final results of the study, including any findings, conclusions,  
15 comments, or recommendations of the appropriate committee, be reported to the 70th Legislature.
