



1 (b) review other shooting facilities in the region and develop preliminary specifications, plans, and  
2 features for the Montana state shooting complex;

3 (c) develop a request for proposals so that local governments, private sector entities, or a  
4 combination of both may submit proposals to be considered for the location of the Montana state shooting  
5 complex; and

6 (d) make recommendations for the development, location, and administrative structure of the  
7 Montana state shooting complex to the governor, the joint appropriations subcommittee on natural resources  
8 and transportation, and the joint fish, wildlife, and parks committee.

9 (3) A vacancy in the task force must be filled in the same manner as members are appointed  
10 under subsection (1).

11 (4) By June 30, 2027, the task force shall report to the governor and the economic affairs interim  
12 committee.

13 (5) The task force is allocated to the department of fish, wildlife, and parks for administrative  
14 purposes only as provided in 2-15-121.

15 (6) (a) Except as provided in subsection (6)(b) and unless otherwise provided by law, each  
16 member is entitled to be paid \$100 for each day in which the member is engaged in the performance of duties  
17 under this section and is also entitled to be reimbursed for travel expenses, as provided for in 2-18-501 through  
18 2-18-503, incurred while performing task force duties.

19 (b) Members who are full-time, salaried officers or employees of this state or of a political  
20 subdivision of this state are not entitled to be compensated for their service as members except when they  
21 perform their task force duties outside of their regular working hours or during hours charged against their leave  
22 time, but those members are entitled to be reimbursed for travel expenses as provided for in 2-18-501 through  
23 2-18-503.

25 **NEW SECTION. Section 2. Montana state shooting complex account.** (1) There is a Montana  
26 state shooting complex account in the state special revenue fund established in 17-2-102. The account is  
27 administered by the department of commerce.

28 (2) Money transferred from a lawful source, including but not limited to gifts, grants, donations,

1 securities, and other assets, public or private, may be deposited in the account.

2 (3) Money in the account may be used only for the siting and construction of the Montana state  
3 shooting complex.

4 (4) Interest and income earned on the account and any unspent or unencumbered money in the  
5 account at the end of a fiscal year must remain in the account.

7 **NEW SECTION. Section 3. Appropriation.** (1) There is appropriated \$55,000 from the general fund  
8 to the department of fish, wildlife, and parks for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, for the purposes  
9 described in [section 1].

10 (2) Money from the appropriation that is not spent during the biennium must revert to the general  
11 fund.

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13 **NEW SECTION. Section 4. Effective date.** [This act] is effective July 1, 2025.

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15 **NEW SECTION. Section 5. Termination.** [Section 1] terminates June 30, 2027.

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
