**Description of fiscal impact:** HB 214 defines instructional opportunities for students. This bill creates no additional state fiscal impact.

### FISCAL ANALYSIS

**Assumptions:**

- This bill provides clarifying definitions to distinguish in-person offsite instructional settings and remote instruction. The proposal also revises related definitions and statutes, including remote instruction for out-of-district students as a circumstance for mandatory attendance agreements under certain conditions providing fractional enrollment for ANB calculations when a student is enrolled in multiple school districts.

**Technical Notes:**

- The definition of *remote instruction* is unclear as to if these situations are limited to opportunities within the state of Montana or if the intent is to include out-of-state or global opportunities.
