**Description of fiscal impact:** This bill has no fiscal impact to the state.


### FISCAL ANALYSIS


**Assumptions:**

- HB 227 amends the conditions that must be met before a court can order financial contributions by parents who are in dependent neglect (DN) cases and whose children have been removed. Although statute allows for judges presiding over DN cases to order such contributions, they do not currently do so. The department follows federal guidance related to child support obligations in child protections cases and has policies in place related to child support obligations. There is no fiscal impact to the department.

**Technical Notes:**

- Assignment of rights to child support for children in foster care is a federal requirement of operating both these programs. The fiscal impact of implementing the federal policy have been incorporated into the department's HB 2 request.
