### FISCAL ANALYSIS

**Assumptions:****Department of Public Health & Human Services (DPHHS)**

- HB 293, Section 6 addresses inspection and notification of violation of persons selling or distributing alternative nicotine products. DPHHS assumes the inspections would have an immaterial fiscal impact and costs will be absorbed within the current budget.

**Department of Revenue (DOR)**

- HB 293 relocates the definitions and regulations of alternative nicotine and vapor products from its current location to its own section. It does not change the current administration or enforcement of these products. There will be no fiscal impact.
