**Description of fiscal impact:** SB 388 has no fiscal impact to the state.

### FISCAL ANALYSIS

**Assumptions:**

**Department of Fish, Wildlife & Parks (FWP)**

1. The department would add the option for a Class B-1 license purchaser to choose either one 14-day period or two 7-day hunting periods at the time of purchase. This would be no cost as the licensing sales system currently includes this functionality.
2. FWP would implement the purchasing limits for both the Class B-1 and Class B-2 licenses. This would be no cost as the licensing sales system currently includes this functionality.
3. In license year 2022, there were no nonresidents who purchased more than 4 Class B-2 3-day upland game bird licenses. The department assumes that the limit this bill imposes on the sale of Class B-2 licenses would not impact license sales for future years.
4. This bill is effective October 1, 2023, however Class B-1 and Class B-2 upland game bird licenses are sold by license year beginning March 1 through the end of February. In license year 2023, Class B-1 and Class B-2 licenses sold from March 1, 2023 to September 30, 2023 would not be limited to the time-period constraints

nor the purchasing limits. Anyone who purchases a Class B-1 or Class B-2 license October 1, 2023 or later would be limited to the time-period constraints and purchasing limits of this bill.

5. Class B-1 licenses are included in the nonresident combination licenses. Those applications must be submitted to the department from March 1 to April 1. These combination licenses are then issued through a random drawing process. As explained above, the department would add the option for the nonresident applicant to choose either the 14-day or two 7-day periods for hunting upland game birds. FWP does not issue any modifications to a license after it is issued. If the nonresident elects these hunting dates when they apply (between March 1 and April 1), and their travel plans change, the department will not issue a corrected license for their modified travel dates. FWP assumes SB 388 does not allow for modifications to the dates selected.
