4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REVISING ELECTRONIC DRIVER'S LICENSE PRIVACY LAW;
5 PROVIDING THAT DISPLAYING AN ELECTRONIC DRIVER'S LICENSE ON AN ELECTRONIC DEVICE
6 DOES NOT CONSTITUTE CONSENT TO A SEARCH OR SEIZURE OF THE ELECTRONIC DEVICE."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 NEW SECTION. Section 1. Displaying electronic driver's license. Displaying an electronic driver's
11 license on an electronic device or handing an electronic device displaying an electronic driver's license to a
12 peace officer does not constitute consent to a search or seizure of the electronic device.

14 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
15 integral part of Title 61, chapter 5, part 3, and the provisions of Title 61, chapter 5, part 3, apply to [section 1].
