A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REVISING NONRESIDENT UPLAND GAME BIRD LICENSES; LIMITING HUNTING PERIODS TO 14 DAYS; ALLOWING UP TO TWO LICENSES FOR 14-DAY PERMITS AND FOUR LICENSES FOR 3-DAY PERMITS; AMENDING SECTIONS 87-2-402 AND 87-2-405, MCA; AND PROVIDING A DELAYED EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 87-2-402, MCA, is amended to read:

"87-2-402. Class B-1--nonresident upland game bird license. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, a person who is not a resident, as defined in 87-2-102, but who is 12 years of age or older or who will turn 12 years old before or during the season for which the license is issued, upon payment of a fee of \$110 may receive a Class B-1 license that entitles a the holder who is 12 years of age or older to hunt upland game birds and possess the carcasses of upland game birds as authorized by department rules.

(2) Licenses A license issued under this section are is valid for any period of 14 consecutive days or any two periods of seven-7 consecutive days provided that the person designates at least the first seven-day 7-day period at the time of fee payment.

(3) A person issued a license under this section may not purchase a 3-day license pursuant to 87-2-405."

(4) A person eligible for a B-1 license under this section may purchase up to two licenses in a single season.
