Assumptions:

- SB 564 Section 7 proposes immunity for the physician from any cause of action associated with the services provided if a physician does not submit a claim to Medicare or Medicaid, as long as the care rendered is within the physician's scope of practice. While it references Medicaid in the bill, this does not have an impact on the Department of Public Health and Human Services.
