A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE BEST BEGINNINGS CHILD CARE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM; SETTING THE INCOME ELIGIBILITY LEVEL AT 200% OF THE FEDERAL POVERTY LEVEL; REQUIRING A MONTHLY COPAYMENT FROM AN ELIGIBLE FAMILY; PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION; AMENDING SECTION 52-2-713, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. **Section 1. Best beginnings child care scholarship program.** There is a best beginnings child care scholarship program administered by the department. The program is established to provide scholarships to qualified low-income families whose child received care provided by a licensed child care provider or day-care facility.

NEW SECTION. **Section 2. Family income eligibility requirements.** In determining income eligibility for the best beginnings child care scholarship program, the department shall set a qualifying income threshold at no less than 200% of the federal poverty level for each family size.

NEW SECTION. **Section 3. Copayment requirements.** Each eligible family shall participate in the cost of child care by making a copayment. The department shall establish the following copayment amounts:

- (1) for an eligible family with a qualifying income less than 100% of the federal poverty level, a copayment of \$10 for each eligible family for each month; and
- (2) for an eligible family with a qualifying income of 100% of the federal poverty level or more, a copayment based on a sliding fee scale not to exceed 7% of an eligible family's monthly income.
